

Scripture Verses for Life Plan



Set aside 30 to 45 minutes to identify verses that you can put in your life accounts. Below are some verses to help you get started but don't let them limit you. If a particular verse strikes you, you might want to read it in the larger context. Then write down the verse in the account on the worksheet provided or in a journal or other document. Feel free to add other inspiring quotes that are not from Scripture to those accounts.

GOD and FAITH

No longer do I call you servants, for the servant does not know what his master is doing; but I have called you friends, for all that I have heard from my Father I have made known to you. - **John 15:15**

Thus says the Lord, "Let not the wise man glory in his wisdom, let not the mighty man glory in his might, let not the rich man glory in his riches; but let him who glories glory in this, that he understands and knows me, that I am the Lord who practices steadfast love, justice, and righteousness in the earth; for in these things I delight says the Lord."
